To qualify for membership, a candidate must:

- Be an NMRA member (either regular or affiliate)
- Attend a minimum of three regular monthly business meetings
- Attend regular meetings, work sessions, or special club functions for an additional six (6) hours.

The candidate is expected to demonstrate skills in areas of model railroading or a willingness to develop such skills as required. Typical skills include carpentry, laying track, wiring, building scenery and building structures, building cars and locomotives.

The candidate shall be granted probationary membership for ninety (90) days while the above qualifying steps are performed.

The candidate for membership will be required to pay regular monthly dues of \$20 during the probationary period. These dues shall be non-refundable.

Regular business meetings are the first Tuesday of each month at 7:30 PM.

Work sessions are held on other Tuesdays, or special times as may be agreed upon by the club. Starting time is formally 7:30 PM, but members are often at the Club from 5:00 PM.
